A message to the school community from Friends of St Peter's



Now we're a few weeks into the new school year, I wanted to give an update on school fundraising and update everyone on the exciting plans we have in the pipeline (including the return of our famous Bonfire and Fireworks night!), as well as highlighting how the money raised in the last academic year has benefited our children.

Many parents will already be aware of the Friends of St Peters Association, which is our PTA. But if you're new to the school, its purpose is simple – to raise much needed funds to enrich and improve the school experience for our pupils, with the aim to have lots of fun together as a school community along the way!

In the past year, Friends raised over £10,000 for our school – a huge achievement only possible through YOU, the school community, who organised, volunteered at and attended over 17 events. These funds have helped to cover costs such as 700 new reading books, multimedia IT equipment and most excitingly, a brand-new playground area which is being constructed during half term.

It goes without saying that right now, every penny counts. We know that the current financial climate is putting extra pressure on families, and the community, and as a school we are feeling it too. School budgets are stretched further than ever and without the additional fundraising we're able to generate through Friends, we simply wouldn't be able to fund projects like new play equipment and Christmas parties. On this note, the school is here to support any families that are struggling at the moment, please don't hesitate to contact the school office in confidence by email or phone if you need some assistance.

Many hands make 'light' work, which is fitting – as we're about to relaunch our famous Bonfire and Fireworks Night! Taking place on Saturday 4th November, we are so excited to bring back this event for the first time since the pandemic, which has always brought together our school and local Heswall community so wonderfully. But we need YOU to make it happen.



Our Summer Fair was a huge success and raised £4,750, but we did struggle to get enough volunteers to run everything required – which meant some stalls closed early and others could only stay open when volunteers kindly stayed on beyond their allocated slots. So this is a plea for help to make this our most successful Bonfire Night yet – by sparing an hour, you really can make all the difference, creating a special event to remember and raising funds that will directly benefit all the children of St Peters. The types of things we'll need volunteers for are:

- ✓ Parents/grandparents/friends who can help takes turns to steward and marshal, run the gates and run stalls
- ✓ People to man the gates and welcome the community to the event
- ✓ Help with the set up and post event clean up


