Parent & Teacher Meetings

Lost Property

We strongly encourage the children to take responsibility for looking after their belongings, but from time to time items are mislaid and end up in 'Lost Property.' When such items are clearly named it enables them to be quickly reunited with their owner. Unfortunately, far too often, items are not named or the name has faded making it impossible to return them.

All named items are collected and stored in Reception at the front of school (by the school office), whilst unnamed items are kept separately outside the new sports cupboard, below the new staff room. Please can you help us to help you by ensuring all of your child's belongings are clearly named – Thank you.

We always really appreciate the additional help and support from parents and grandparents, who are able to spare a few hours during the week to help in school, whether it be to hear readers, work with a small group or provide general support in the classroom.
